Day 1: DEPART USA

Start your journey aboard an overnight flight. Meals will be served on board.

Day 2: FATIMA

Upon arrival in Lisbon there will be a panoramic sightseeing tour of Portugal's capital city from the motorcoach, passing by the Rossio and Comercio squares, to the Alfama, the oldest quarter of Lisbon, to visit the **Church of St. Anthony** and the nearby **St. Anthony Museum** and the **Cathedral**. Proceed to the Belem Tower, the Monument to the Discoveries and the Jeronimos Church. Depart for Fatima, one of the most famous Marian Shrines in Europe. In the afternoon, visit the **Capelinha** (the "Chapel of the Apparitions") and the **Basilica**, which contains the tombs of the children of Fatima, Jacinta and Francisco, and Sr. Lucia. Dinner and overnight in Fatima. **(D)** In the evenings you may participate in the candlelight procession.

Day 3: FATIMA

In the morning the group will visit the small village of **Aljustrel**, home of Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta, the three children who witnessed the Apparitions of the Blessed Mother starting in 1917. Then visit **Valinhos**, where Our Lady appeared in August of that year, and the parish church where the children were baptized and where family members were buried in the cemetery. An **OPTIONAL** video presentation on the history of Fatima will be offered at the Consolata Fathers Center. Dinner overnight in Fatima. **(B,D)**

DAY 4: FATIMA (OPTIONAL: BATALHA, ALCOBACA & NAZARE)

Enjoy a day at leisure Fatima or if you wish take part in an **OPTIONAL** side trip will be made available to make a visit and tour the famous monasteries of Batalha, Alcobaca as well as spend some time at leisure in Nazare, a quaint fishing village with lunch on your own. Upon returning to Fatima for the evening, participate in the Candlelight Procession and Evening Rosary (in season). Dinner and overnight in Fatima. **(B,D)**

Day 5: FATIMA / PORTO / SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

After breakfast depart Fatima for the journey to Santiago de Compostela, Spain. En route, stop in Porto. Porto is one of the oldest European centers and is registered as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Porto was named for its most famous export, Port Wine. We visit the **Porto Cathedral**, located in the historical center of the city. It is one of the city's oldest monuments and one of the most important monuments in Portugal. The current Cathedral of Porto underwent construction around 1110, and was completed in the 13th century. Continue to Santiago for dinner and overnight. **(B,D)**

Day 6: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

The group will take part in a tour of one of Europe's most spectacular basilicas, the **Cathedral of St. James**. Also visit the **Plaza del Obradoiro**, **Archbishop's Palace**, and the **Rajoy Palace**, presently being used as the city hall. Your guided walking tour of the city will include a visit to the churches of **San Francisco**, **San Roque** and **Santa Clara** where the tombs of St. Theodore, and St. Anthonasius are housed. Dinner and overnight in Santiago. **(B,D)**

Day 7: SANTIAGO / ALBA DE TORMES / AVILA

After breakfast at the hotel depart Santiago for the journey to Avila, the City of Kings and of Saints, completely encircled by 11th century walls. This is the birthplace of St. Theresa one of the greatest mystics of the Church. En route, stop in Alba de Tormes where St. Teresa is buried and her body is venerated. Continue to Avila for dinner and overnight in Avila. **(B,D)**

Day 8: AVILA / MADRID

Avila is most famous for being the home of St. Teresa, one of only three female doctors of the Church. Avila's atmosphere has changed very little since the days of St. Theresa, to whom the city is dedicated. St. Theresa the great mystic, was the first woman to be named a Doctor of the Church. 2015 is the 500th Anniversary of the birth of St. Teresa. In the morning we will visit the city of Avila: the **Cathedral**, which contains many of St. Theresa relics; **The crypt of the Convento of La Santa**, built on the site of the house where she was born, is home to the most comprehensive museum dedicated to her life, and **La Encarnacion Convent**, the first convent she found. Continue to Madrid with the balance of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Madrid. **(B,D)**

Day 9: MADRID

After breakfast, enjoy a panoramic tour of Madrid, with a visit to the **Prado** and **Royal Palace** and the **Plaza Major**. Dinner and overnight in Madrid. Dinner and overnight in Madrid. **(B,D)**

Day 10: MADRID / USA

Transfer to the airport for our return flights. Arrive U.S. same day. **(B)**

(Deposits, Second payments, and Final payments)

*A deposit of \$300 is required no later than 95 days prior to departure to secure a reservation. There is no guarantee we can obtain airline seats for late bookings. FULL payment is due no later than 65 days prior to departure. Late payments can be assessed a \$100 late fee. Reservations may be cancelled and we reserve the right to levy full cancellation charges as set forth in these conditions if full payment is not received 65 days prior to the departure date of the tour. In the event of billing error, we reserve the right to reinvoice with correct pricing. Final documents and tickets will be issued after final payment has been processed, and normally will be sent 1 – 2 weeks prior to departure.

General:

*Deposit is necessary to secure a reservation.

*For late bookings (within 60 days of departure), full payment is due immediately by bank check or money order. No reservations will be accepted 45 days or less before departure.

*Late bookings (within 60 days of departure) are subject to a \$100.00 late fee plus any increase in quoted airfare.

*All payments, except late bookings, can be made by personal check, bank check or money order. Visa, MasterCard and Discover will be accepted for all payments except late bookings. Credit cards will not be accepted for reservations made by travel agents.

*No personal checks or credit cards will be accepted with payments 45 days or less before departure date. Only money orders or cashier's checks will be accepted.

CANCELLATION INFORMATION:

All Cancellations must be in writing to us and must be signed by the person who made the original reservation. Cancellations are only effective from the day they are actually received by The Catholic Tour. US Postmark prevails. No refunds are issued for cancellations received after the departure date of the tour. Penalties will apply. If you cancel your tour, cancellation fees and penalties will be deducted from your refund. Cancellation fees do apply to deposit checks. Cancellation fees apply to each person.

ROOMS: Prices are based on double occupancy. Single rooms are available at a supplementary cost as stated on individual itineraries. A limited number of single rooms are available. On those very rare occasions when we are not able to get a roommate for you, you will be required to pay the single supplement. We will attempt to give sufficient prior notice to any room changes regarding double occupancy versus single supplement. Triple rooms may not be available in all countries.

TAXES: Tour price includes all government taxes and fees associated with the airfare. Please see individual itineraries for prices, which may vary. **Departure taxes and fuel surcharges may increase subsequent to the printing of the brochure or flyer** up until the time the group seats are purchased, typically 45 days prior to departure.

TIPPING: The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the Tour Escort and Motor Coach Driver approximately €4 / \$5 and €2 / \$3 per person, respectively, per day to each; local step-on guides 1-2 Euros per day. **Hotel tips are not included in tours to the Middle East or on some other tours. Please refer to the individual itinerary.**

SIGHTSEEING & ITINERARIES: Sightseeing is included as per the itinerary and is under the direction of licensed local guides where required. During holidays

some sights such as museums may be closed or unavailable for visits. The Catholic Tour reserves the right to vary the sequence of sightseeing and / or to re-route the order of cities should circumstances demand it. In either case, the itinerary content will be maintained; however, the order may change. **Considerable amount of walking may be necessary while sightseeing.** Please understand that not all museums and attractions are open every day of the year. The Papal Audience takes place on Wednesdays, and the Papal Blessing is on Sundays. Both are only available in accordance with His Holiness' schedule, and may not take place when He is out of the country. There are no refunds for any unused portion of these excursions. Optional side trips and optional extensions need a minimum number of pilgrims to operate.

MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Handicapped participants who require special assistance **must** be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the handicapped participants' well being. The Catholic Tour is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during or after the tour.

BAGGAGE: The passenger is allowed to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 61 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH:

Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. **Group air is not upgradable to First Class, Business Class, Economy Plus, etc. It is common for carriers to give partial or no mileage credit for group seats.** Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from same. **Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets.** We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. **Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.**

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES.

Note that "bulkhead" and "exit row" seats are assigned by the carrier at the airport. The Catholic Tour can never guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companion. Three hours advance arrival to departing airport is required.

Passports should be in your possession before a reservation is made. Some countries require Visas. The Catholic Tour assumes no responsibility or liability for Visa procurement.
